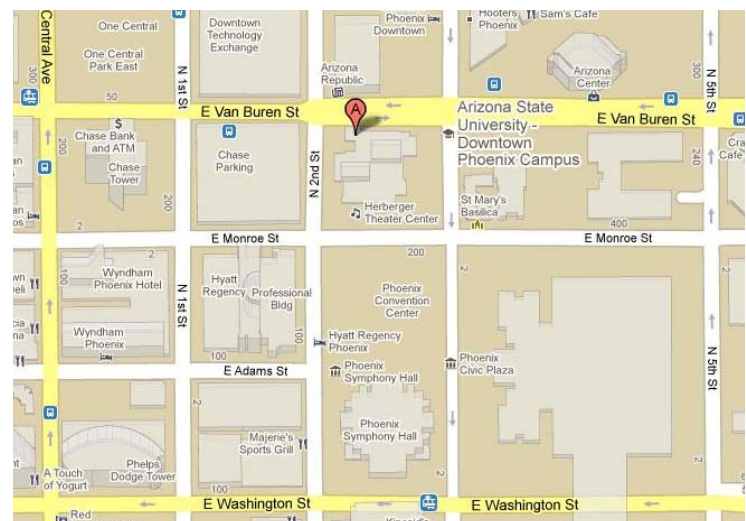
Technical Director Randy Levine will be giving us a personal Lunch Time Tour of the newly updated and renovated theater.
